

Plaksha University Undergraduate Admissions Policies

Eligibility:

- Applicants should be currently enrolled in grade 12 or equivalent or should have completed grade 12 or equivalent.
- Plaksha accepts students from all recognized national and international boards.
- Mathematics and Physics till grade 12 is required for students wishing to opt for majors in
 1. Computer Science & Artificial Intelligence
 2. Robotics & Cyber-Physical Systems
 3. Biological Systems Engineering
- Students wishing to opt for a major in Data Science, Economics and Business should have studied Math till grade 12 and can be from a non-science background.

Required Scores:

Grade X - Best of 5 scores considered, including Math and Science.

Grade XII

- Best of 4 scores considered, including Math and Physics for National and State Boards.
- Minimum 3 A Level for IGCSE Boards.
- All 6 scores, including Math and Physics for IB Boards.

(Only Math if the student is from a non-science background applying for DSEB)

International Baccalaureate (IB) specific policies

We accept students from

- IB Diploma Programme
- IB Certificate Course- applicants must have the subject prerequisites. Students in IB Certificate Course, should have taken a minimum of 6 subjects (3 Standard Level and 3 Higher Level).
- IB Career-related Programme (CP). In terms of subjects, it will be mandatory for students to have subject prerequisites as their DP courses to qualify for Plaksha.

We accept the following variants of Mathematics

- Analysis and Approaches: Higher Level and Standard Level
- Applications and Interpretations: Higher Level

To receive a confirmed offer of admission, applicants are required to submit at least one of the following scores:

1. Grade 12th (or equivalent) Board Results
2. Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT)
3. American College Testing (ACT)
4. Joint Entrance Examination (JEE) Main

Students who apply using only predicted scores are eligible for a **conditional offer of admission**.

The offer of admission will be revoked in any case where the applicant does not clear grade 12 satisfactorily.

Admissions Process:

- An applicant can apply only once in any of the five rounds of the Admissions cycle 2022-23. There is no difference in applying in either of the rounds. We encourage applicants to apply early, so that they receive their decision earlier.
- Shortlisted students will be invited for a virtual interaction.
- The Financial Aid form will be open to candidates only after they have been shortlisted for the interview round.
- The choice of preferred major specified in the application form is only indicative in nature. You are free to change it during the program when you declare your major.
- All applicants are required to upload copies of their official transcripts for the standardized tests.
- Admission decisions will be communicated to candidates after the assessment of applications received in each round.
- The decisions taken by the Admissions Committee are final. Requests for re-evaluation will not be considered.

Types of Decisions:

Firm Offer: A candidate is eligible to receive a firm offer of admission from Plaksha based on the information submitted in the application as well as their performance in the Innovation Challenge and personal conversation rounds. Candidates must have one of the following scores to receive a firm offer Grade 12 or equivalent examination, SAT, ACT, JEE Main.

Conditional Offer:

In the absence of Grade 12 or equivalent examination final scores, a candidate is required to submit predicted scores, which are indicative of their performance in their final Grade 12 or equivalent examination results.

The candidate is required to meet the condition which is mentioned in the decision letter received from the Office of Admissions.

Deferral of Decision: The candidate's application will be re-evaluated no later than August 1, 2022* (subject to final Grade 12 or equivalent examination results)

Denial of Admission: The admissions committee is unable to admit the student after carefully evaluating all the information provided by them.
